The Psychological Center is the training clinic for the CUNY Doctoral Program in Clinical Psychology located at The City College of New York.

We are a community-oriented outpatient psychological and behavioral health center, established in 1966 to serve the practicum training goals of the doctoral program as well as the needs of City College and the community.

We offer individualized therapy as well as psychiatric care and support for our patients.

WHAT WE PROVIDE

The Psychological Center provides the following services:

- Psychological evaluations
- Individual therapy for children, adolescents, and adults
- Group therapy
- Couples and family therapy
- Psychological testing for children, adolescents, and adults
- Psychiatric treatment

WHAT TO EXPECT
