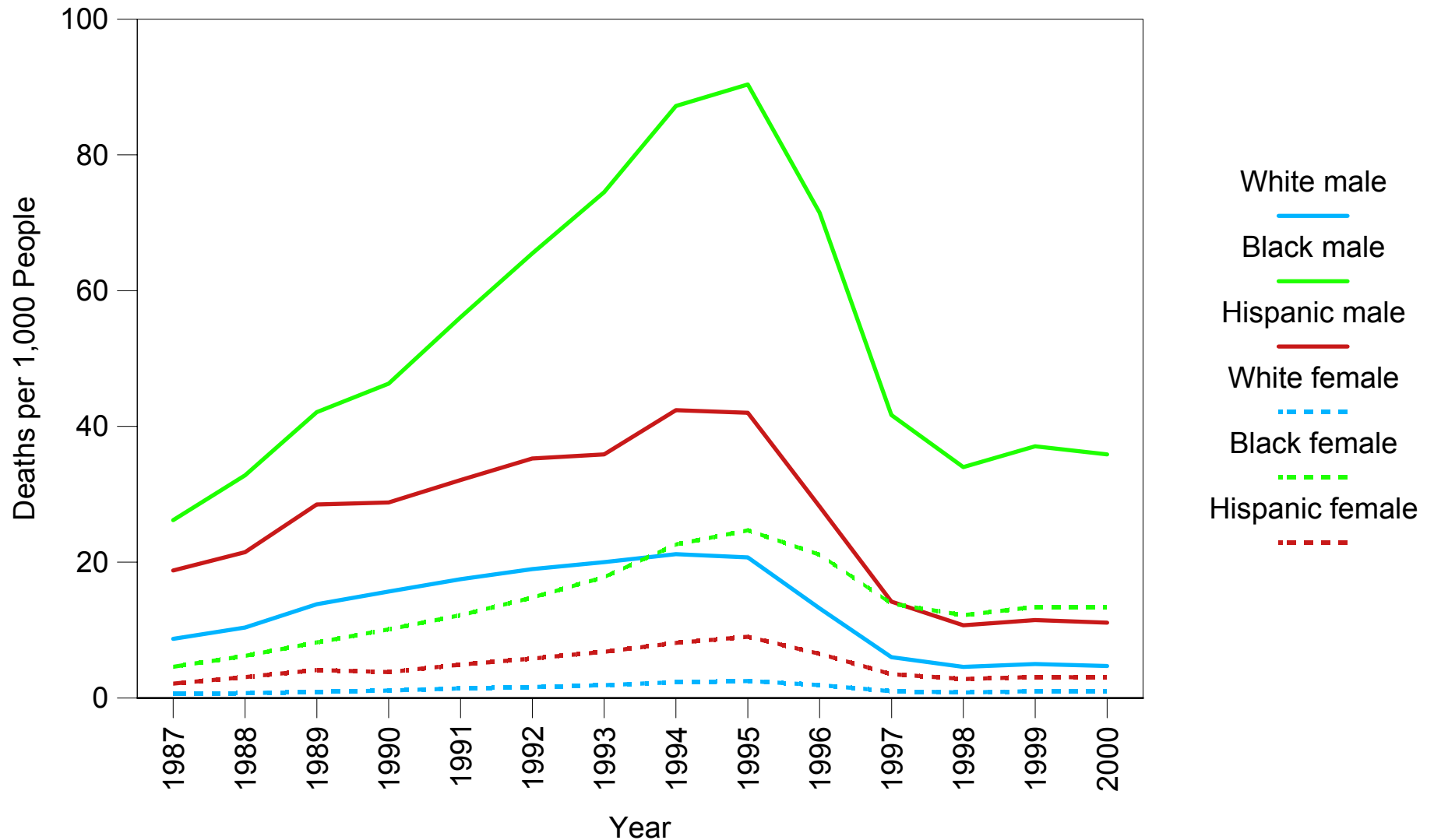


## Death Rates per 1,000 Population from HIV by Sex, Race/Nationality, 1987-2000
