He has published over thirty articles and is co-editor of *Selling Places: the city as cultural capital, past and present* (Pergamon, 1993). He is currently working on *Geopolitics and Empire*, a book about the relations between the ideologies of Victorian-British and Neo-Conservative-American imperialism.
